

Physical Education Extra-Curricular & Trips Policy

Sports Teams (inter-school competitions)

Competitions we enter will be classified as 'competitive' or 'inclusive' by the event organizer.

'Competitive' competition selection:

- School will select pupils who have demonstrated the highest level of skill and ability.

'Inclusive' competition selection:

- Any pupil can be selected.
- School will take into consideration; pupils who have had fewer opportunities, commitment to extra-curricular clubs, pupil desire to have such experiences, and potential impact on pupil wellbeing.

Clubs

Our sports clubs are open to anyone who wishes to take part. Clubs will only be restricted by:

- Age group - all clubs will have a target age group(s) to ensure activities can be run safely and effectively.
- Maximum number of attendees - all clubs will have a maximum number of children who can attend to ensure that activities can be run safely and effectively. Spaces are allocated on a first come first served basis.
- Gender - all sports clubs will be mixed (except for football).

Sports clubs ran by our PE department will be mainly targeted at pupils in KS2 (years 3 to 6). Our sports clubs run in line with inter-school competitions in Warwickshire (the vast majority of which are targeted at KS2 age groups).

Trips

Sports trips will be offered to pupils in years 5 and 6 only.

- Any pupil in year 5 or 6 can apply to attend sports trips.
- There will be a limit of attendees based on transport and ability to purchase tickets.
- A ballot will be held when a sports trip is over subscribed.
- Pupils can attend more than one sports trip per school year. Pupils who have not attended a sports trip will be given priority in the ballot over pupils that have attended a sports trip in that school year. This system is reset at the start of every new school year.
